We are seeking a highly motivated postdoctoral fellow to conduct research at the interface of neuroscience and immunology. The project aims to understand how microglial metabolism changes upon innate immune stimulation, and the impact of key metabolites on canonical microglial function. In particular, the role of the NLRP3 inflammasome will be assessed, and the influence of aging or prior pathology, such as Alzheimer's disease.

We are looking for an enthusiastic scientist, with a desire to work on a rewarding project as a part of a supportive, international team. Applicants with a PhD, or expecting to graduate within the next four months will be considered. The ideal candidate will have a background in immunology, neuroscience or cell metabolism. Experience working with cell culture (e.g. murine microglia or microglia generated from human iPSCs), animal models, metabolic assays, flow cytometry, fluorescence imaging or biochemical techniques will be preferred.
