

## **Guidelines for abstract submission**

File format: Please upload a .doc or .docx file!

Abstracts should contain max. 1900 characters with spaces.

Title: max. 200 characters with spaces

For submission you will have to indicate in which session your presentation/poster can be presented:

*Research Area A:* Immune Sensing Receptors and Modulators

*Research Area B:* Local Context Sensing

*Research Area C:* Metabolic Sensing and Nervous-Immune System Interactions

*Research Area D:* Integration of Immune Sensory System Input on the Cellular and Subcellular Level

*Research Area E:* Consequences of Immune Sensing for Sterile Inflammation in Vivo

*Technical developments:* Technical developments, new techniques developed or established for/within the Cluster

If you are not sure which area to indicate, please ask your group leader!

### **The abstract should be organized in the following format:**

Title: Max. 200 characters with spaces

Authors:

- Please write all names like: Drescher C.
- Please include the affiliation of all authors e.g. Drescher C.<sup>1</sup>; 1 ImmunoSensation, Bonn
- The submitting author should be listed first and his/her name underlined.
- The group leader should be listed last and his/her name underlined.

Structure: Please also include the following sections and label them clearly

- Background: the context and purpose of the study;
- Methods: how the study was performed and statistical tests used;
- Results: the main findings;
- Conclusions: brief summary and potential implications.

## **Talks & posters**

Several abstracts will be selected for oral presentations.

In addition we will have slots for 3 minutes speed talks before the poster sessions, which can be used to attract people's attention to come to the corresponding poster.

The remaining projects will be presented as a poster during the corresponding poster sessions.

## **eAntrag instructions**

1. Your login credentials are identical to your Cluster IntraNet credentials.  
Email address: most probably the one you received this email with (case sensitive)  
Password: If you forgot your password, you can recover it by clicking on „forgot password?“
